- Advised some requests are regular annual requests. There should be an annual community grants allocation budgeted accompanied by a rigorous applications process, including a vetting committee to consider the requests prior to Council consideration. In response, Chief Administrative Officer Gary Dyke advised that the Director of Finance, Brad Brookman, will be developing and bringing forward for Council's consideration a new process for the evaluation of community grants.
- Deputy Mayor McManaman advised that he was willing to approve the community grants motion subject to the delivery of a rigorous community grants program in the immediate future.

- 2. Authorize the Municipality to enter into a loan with the Ontario Plowmen's Association, or as it may direct, of up to \$100,000 payable in no more than 3 equal tranches at 0% interest (the "IPM Loan"); and
- 4. Authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute: (i) the Hosting Agreement; and (ii) IPM Loan, and all ancillary documents thereto.
- 5. Direct staff to report back with the details of the Hosting Agreement and the IPM Loan at a later date.
