**Suggested Orientation:**

The proposed signage, comparable to the standard No Stopping and No Parking signs, or smaller, could be manufactured and installed on the pedestrian activated flashing beacon light standards on each side of the crosswalk facing the east and west sidewalks of Prescott Street. This type of placement would capture the attention of pedestrians approaching and using the crosswalk.
